

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Intended Use of Data

- Recap using multi-agency data which is high impact, public, collected & shareable
- P20W Reports include sector readiness, postsecondary outcomes and investing in potential.

Next Steps: DGC will validate data readiness, refine report scope and requirements. SLDS will coordinate cross-agency work sessions.

2. National Governors Association

- Presentation on Data & Non-Degree Credentialing by the CNMI State Team (Monique Sablan, Dr. Annette Pladevega-Sablan & Leila Staffler)
- Designed to help states and territories use data more effectively to strengthen workforce development strategies.
- Purpose: Reduce the gap between employers and training providers by focusing on what skills job seekers bring to an organization.

National Data Summit

Overview:
The CNMI team attended the 2025 NGA Data Summit, where states examined how to better integrate **education and workforce data**. The convening was framed by the guiding question:

"How can states align P20W data systems to improve decision-making, equity, and economic mobility?"

Trends:

- States are prioritizing skills-based hiring and high-quality, stackable NDCs.
- High-performing states rely on statute-based data governance to support long-term interoperability.
- Employer voice and labor-market signals are critical for validating which credentials lead to real opportunities.

High Performing States

Across all sessions, states emphasized:


- **Codified data governance** as the foundation for sustainable P20W systems.
- **Centralized coordination** across K-12, higher ed, workforce, and employers.
- Tracking non-degree credentials within SLDS to **evaluate ROI, wage outcomes, and skill pathways**.
- **"Data quality = usability,"** not perfection
- **Employer engagement is essential:** pulse surveys, validation mechanisms, advisory groups.

National Data Summit Key Takeaways

Priority Actions Identified Based on Summit Insights:

- **Codified Data Governance**
 - Explore statutory models to support long-term P20W data sharing and privacy frameworks.
- **Integrate NDC & Workforce Data Into SLDS**
 - Standardize reporting across providers, workforce training programs, and agencies.
- **Adopt a Credentials of Value (CoV) Framework**
 - Identify high-value, stackable credentials for CNMI priority industries.
- **Implement Systematic Employer Engagement**
 - Pulse surveys, sector advisory groups, and feedback loops to align training with real labor demand.

3. P20W Partnerships: Adding New Agencies & Stakeholder Engagement



- SLDS presented to Executive Leadership its review of the CNMI Scholarship & Financial Aid Office as a potential partner to the CNMI P20W partnership.
- DGC endorsed them as a partner for their data contribution, data value and operational impact to the CNMI P20W partnership.

Motion

- Dr. Galvin Guerrero motioned to approve CNMI Scholarship & Financial Aid Office as a partner to the CNMI P20W partnership.
- Dr. Lawrence Camacho seconded the motion.
- Discussion:

- Secretary Norita mentioned that it would be beneficial if CNMI Scholarship is able to request data from municipal scholarships.
- **All 6 members voted to approve CNMI Scholarship & Financial Aid Office as a partner to the CNMI P20W partnership. Motion carries.**

Next Steps: DGM will inform CS&FAO of approval, coordinate the addendum to the MOU, onboard DGC & Executive Leadership members, execute Data Sharing Agreement and coordinate data transfer.
